# Picture Bank

(pack of 20 cards)

The Working With Others approach focuses on practical ways of building positive learning relationships within the classroom.

**The Picture Bank consists of 20 A4 cards showing a variety of full colour abstract pictures.**

These cards offer a practical solution to exploring and enhancing communication and emotional literacy with your pupils. They encourage pupils to

- **reflect on how they are feeling**
- **develop communication skills**
- **build class relationships**

Suitable for use with individuals, small groups of pupils or whole class activities, the Picture Bank can be used to in a variety of ways.

For example, ask pupils to

**a. choose a picture that represents how they are feeling and show it to the class/group giving a reason for their choice**

OR

**b. choose a picture that represents how they are feeling and talk with others who made the same choice**

OR

**c. find a partner and choose a picture together as an initial starting point for a piece of writing, dance or artwork.**
